

EOCRN REACHES 6 MONTH MARK FROM LAUNCH DATE IN SEPTEMBER 2020

EOCRN's membership has grown to 120 members with 56 requests being logged since launching EOCRN. Below the graph shows the requests and what items are trending.

Making a request is not the only activity one can find on EOCRN. People can also share items they would like to donate to others or announce events in the community.



Organization Partner Spotlight: Angel Flight West

Angel Flight West are missions flown by private volunteer pilots in aircraft that they own or rent, or with commercial airline partners. **Angel Flight West** pilots and partners donate their time, flying skills, and all the expenses of each flight.

Mission:

Sometimes the road to health is a runway. If the care you need is far from home, **Angel Flight West** can help.

Who They Serve:

- Patients traveling for non-emergency care at major research and children's hospitals, specialized treatment centers and more.
- Kids attending specialty camps, like those for burn survivors and other patients.
- Domestic violence survivors in need of relocation.
- Veterans and active duty military personnel.
- People with other compelling human needs.

To Qualify:

Patients must

- ⇒ Be medically stable and ambulatory.
- ⇒ Have a scheduled appointment or pending appointment for services not available locally.
- ⇒ Have a financial need or other valid consideration.
- ⇒ Be capable of sitting upright.
- ⇒ If flying privately, be able to fly in a small unpressurized aircraft.

Area Covered:

Alaska, Washington, Oregon, Montana, Idaho, Wyoming, California, Nevada, Utah, Colorado, Arizona, New Mexico, and Hawaii.
