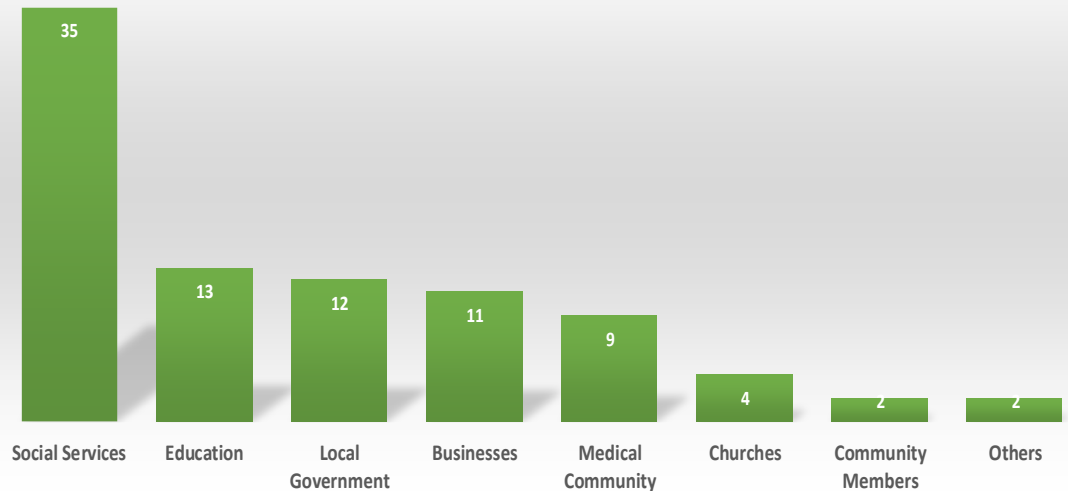

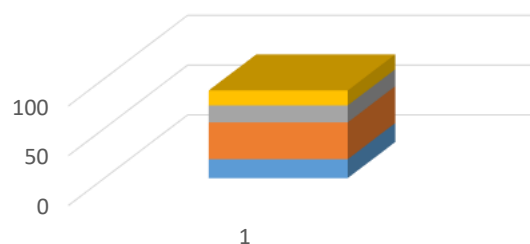
## EOCRN ORGANIZATIONS



Currently there are 88 organizations that belong to EOCRN with 275 members. The largest membership of organizations are social service organizations accounting for 40% of the current memberships. Education tallies at 17%, followed by local governments at 14%, businesses at 13%, medical community at 10%, churches 4%, and both 1% for community members and others.

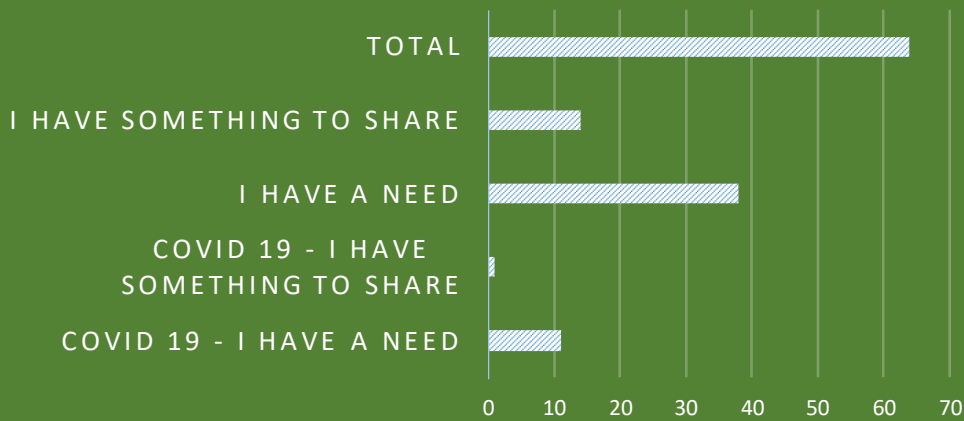
Locations of organizations record 42% from Union County, 22% from Baker County, 19% from Wallowa County, and 17% from counties outside the EOCRN region.

## MATTRESS REQUESTS/SHARES BY PURPOSE

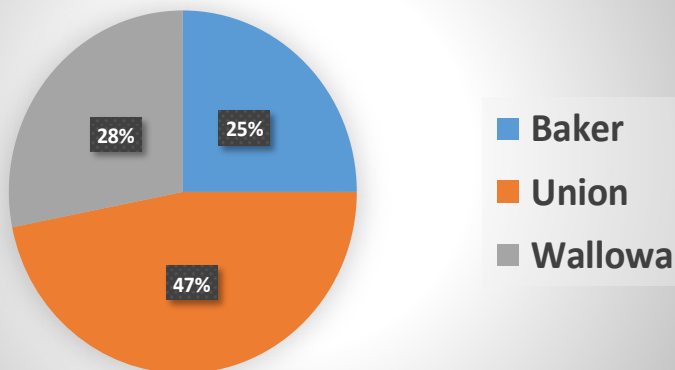


## Mattresses
