Requesting on EOCRN

Before making a request on EOCRN, make sure all other avenues for help have been exhausted. EOCRN is intended to be the last stop to fill an unmet need.

Some tips for posting a request:

1. For a successful request be specific and concise on what items are needed.
2. Complete the request form by filling out the

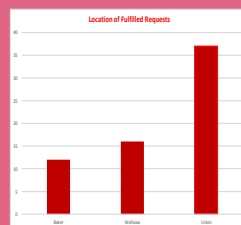
Request Notification Categories. This will track the categories of items requested and shared.

3. Make sure and mark the *Request Locations.* This helps send email notifications in the right direction.
4. Look for emails after posting a request for those offering assistance.
