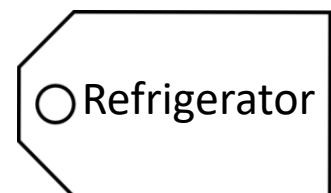
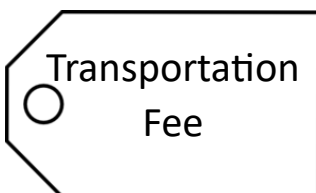
Reminder that Coats for Kids in Union and Wallowa Counties are still available—in Union County at the Evermine Building and in Wallowa County at Building Healthy Families.

The Social Determinants of Health (SDoH) are non-medical factors (*things*) that impact health and well-being. These non-medical factors can include **housing, transportation, education, employment, and food access.**



Addressing SDoH needs can help make sure a person has the resources and support they need to live a healthy and fulfilling life—**whatever that looks like to them.**

By completing the **Member and Community Partner SDoH Screening Survey** you can share your experience with SDoH Screenings [*a screening includes being asked about SDoH needs*] with the Eastern Oregon Coordinated Care Organization (EOCCO).
