

EOCCO Member and Community Partner SDoH Screening Survey

The Social Determinants of Health (SDoH) are non-medical factors (*things*) that impact health and well-being. These non-medical factors can include **housing**, **transportation**, **education**, **employment**, **and food access**.







Addressing SDoH needs can help make sure a person has the resources and support they need to live a healthy and fulfilling life—whatever that looks like to them.

By completing the **Member and Community Partner SDoH Screening Survey** you can share your experience with SDoH Screenings [a screening includes being asked about SDoH needs] with the Eastern Oregon Coordinated Care Organization (EOCCO).
