Each month the EOCRN Newsletter highlights a participating community organization. The information provided in the Community Spotlight is intended to create awareness about services and programs in the community.

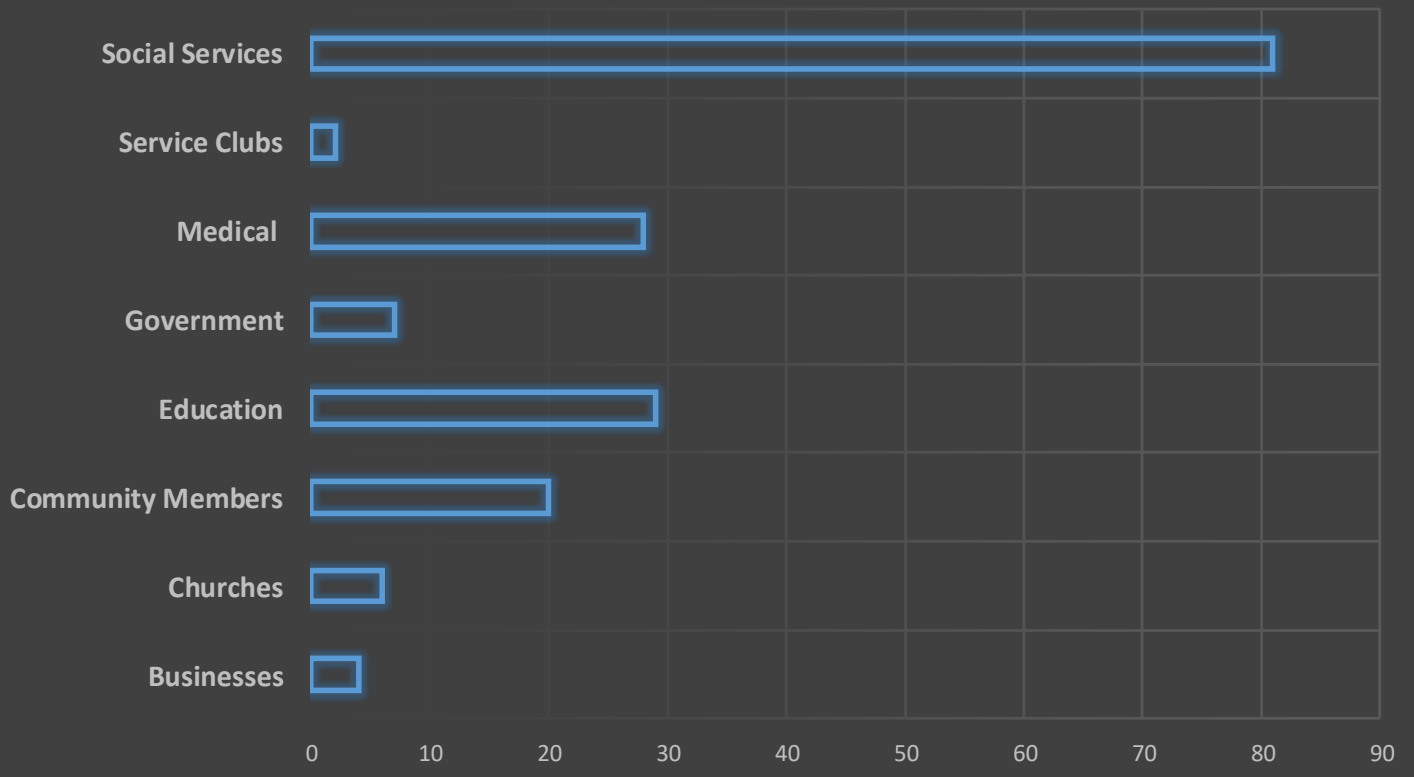


Eastern Oregon CANN

Eastern Oregon COFA & Other Pacific Islander groups work together to ensure that our communities in rural Oregon are able to learn and know their rights, have the knowledge of resources available to them, and know how to access them in ways that barriers are eliminated. The organizational structure includes four elected officers and an advisory board composed to two representatives of each island within the Micronesian region.

The group has recently distributed 20,000 masks in Eastern Oregon; completed 6 food box distributions to the Pacific Islander Community; and partnered with several local agencies.
